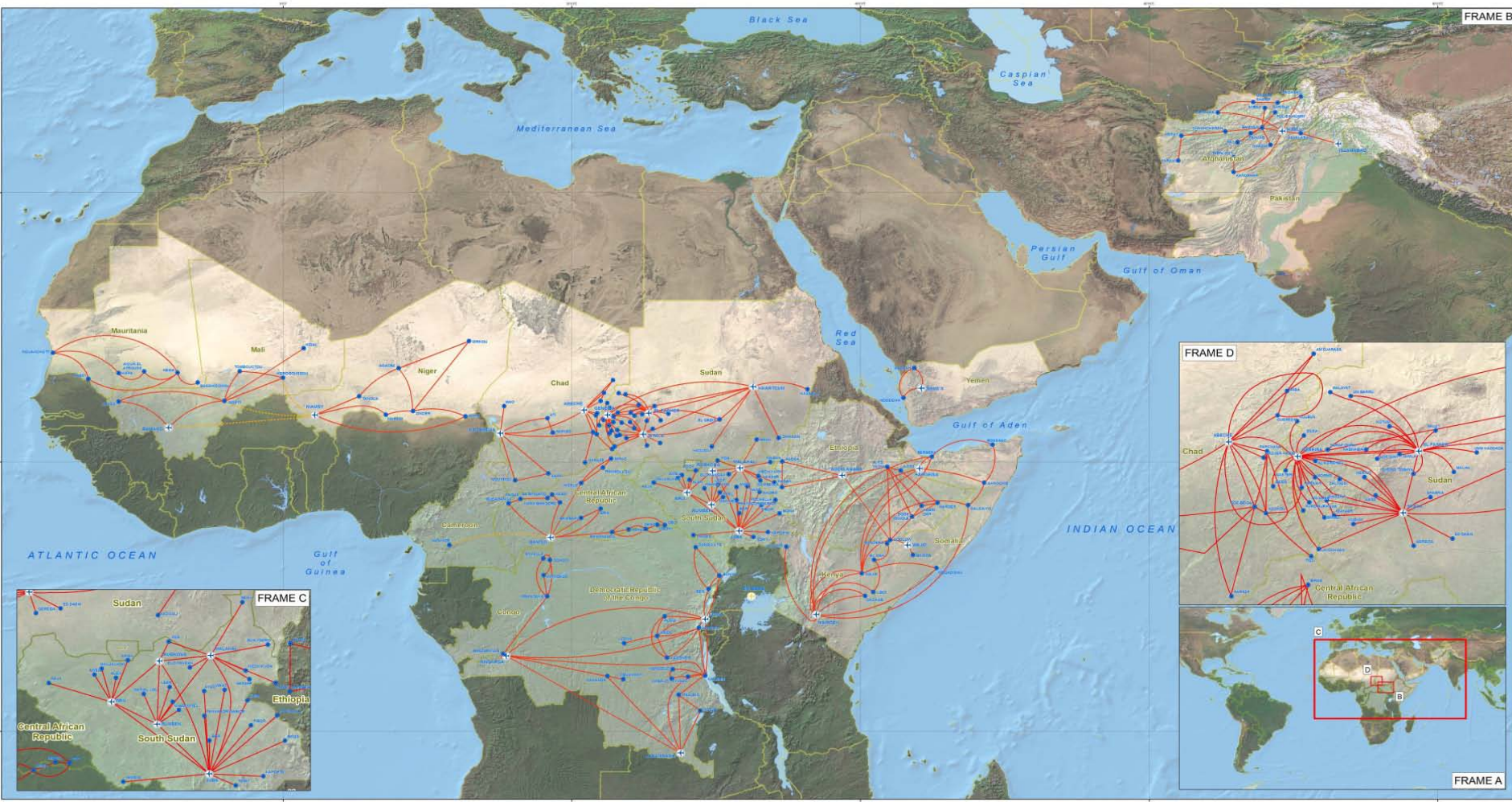


# The Vision

# Air Assets Capacity

## Long Term Passenger/Cargo Air Service

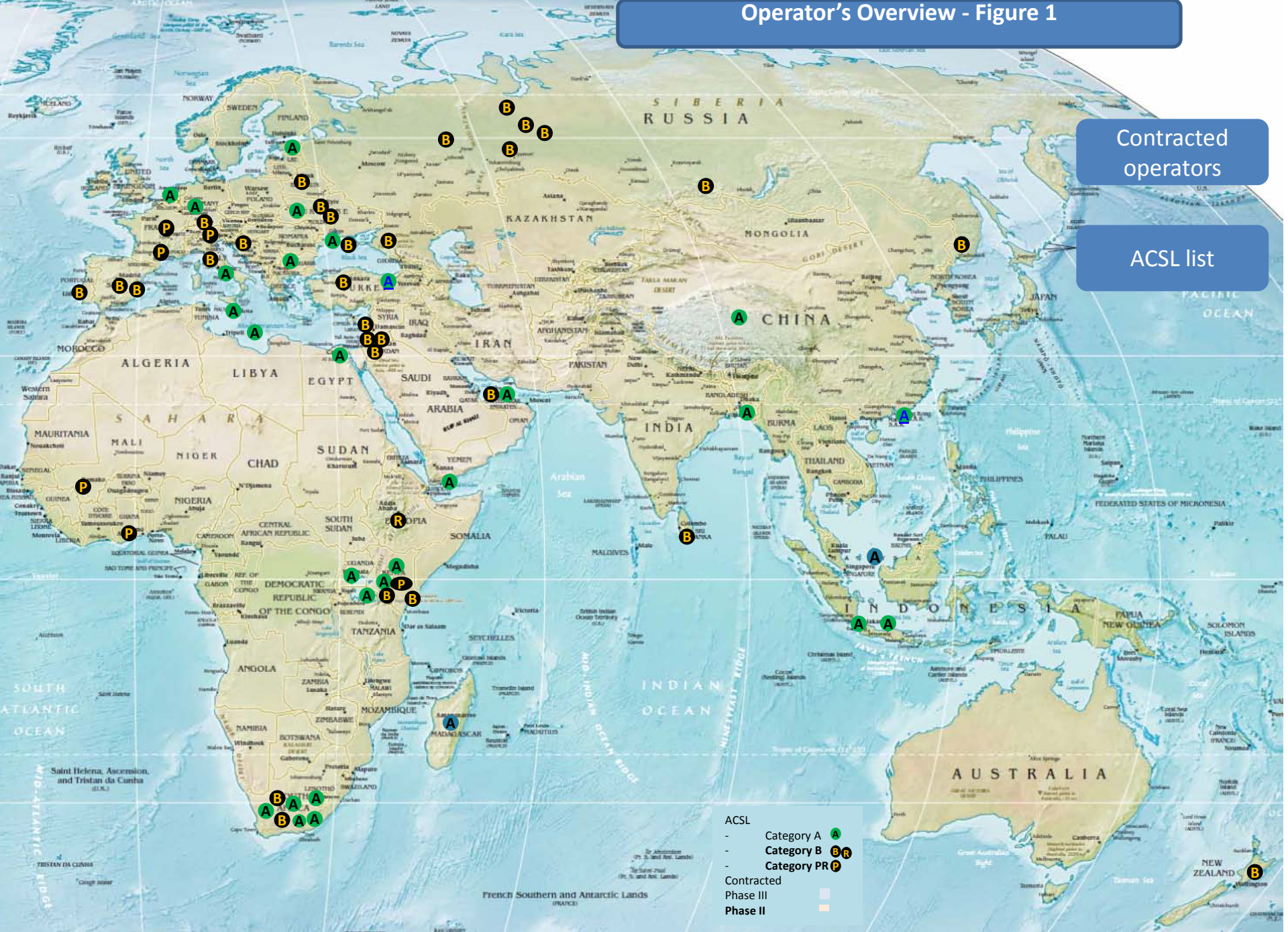
- 86 Registered AOC Holders from 39 countries
- Variety includes over 25 aircraft types from single engine to heavy cargo multi-engine (L410 – Do228, C208 – P750, Emb135, CRJ200, L-382, An12, IL76)
- Geographical distribution comprises Americas, Europe, Africa and Asia.
- Quarterly meetings to prioritise inspection of aircraft/location are held btw ASU and OSLA
- Access to aircraft type / Air Carriers critical mass for emergency response (a min of 10 helicopters, 2 heavy freighters, 4 turboprop airliners)
- Continuous charter market review through media, partners, conferences (identification of trends, available capacities and rates change, BARS system)

## ADHOC Passenger/Cargo Air Service

- 123 registered Global and Regional Service Providers (Brokers, Agents)
- Regional Freight/Long Haul Capacity linkage to UNHRD Depot Network (Gulf Carriers, Malaysia, US Carriers)
- Global Handling and Jet A-1 Fuel Service Contracts
- Monitoring of the fleet capacity: (diversity of offers, ramp/cargo door, RWY limitations)
  - > 15MT Freighters
  - > 40MT Freighters
  - > 100MT Freighters
